

OMAINTEC – EXHIBITOR TERMS & CONDITIONS

Standard Master Agreement & Booth Sharing Policy

This Exhibitor Agreement (the "**Agreement**") is made and entered into by and between the Event Organizer, **OMAINTEC** (hereinafter "**Organizer**"), and the contracted exhibiting company (hereinafter "**Exhibitor**"), regarding space rental at **OMAINTEC 2027**.

1. SPACE ALLOCATION AND USE OF BOOTH

- **Authorized Occupancy:** The space allocated to the Exhibitor is intended solely for the use of the company named on the original booking application.
- **Exclusive Promotion:** The Exhibitor may only display, demonstrate, and promote products, services, or brands that are directly owned, manufactured, or distributed by the Exhibitor in its ordinary course of business.

2. STRICT PROHIBITION AGAINST UNAUTHORIZED SUBLETTING AND SHARING

- **Absolute Restriction:** The Exhibitor shall not assign, sublet, transfer, license, gift, or part with the possession of the whole or any part of the allocated booth space to any third-party company, individual, or entity without the prior express written consent of the Organizer.
- **Prohibition of On-Site Sales:** The Exhibitor is strictly prohibited from "selling off," renting out, or brokering portions of their booth space to unauthorized vendors or partners.
- **Remedies for Violation:** If the Organizer discovers an unauthorized third party operating within the Exhibitor's booth space, the Organizer reserves the absolute right to:
 - Immediately evict the unauthorized third party from the Event venue.
 - Terminate this Agreement immediately without refunding the Exhibitor.
 - Bar both the Exhibitor and the unauthorized party from participating in future events.

3. AUTHORIZED CO-EXHIBITORS AND BOOTH SHARING PROCESS

If the Exhibitor wishes to share its booth space with a corporate partner, subsidiary, or joint-venture entity, it must strictly adhere to the following Co-Exhibitor Approval Process:

- **Formal Application:** The Exhibitor must submit an official Co-Exhibitor Application & Approval Form to the Organizer at least [e.g., 45 days] prior to the Event start date.
- **Organizer Discretion:** Approval of any co-exhibitor is at the sole and absolute discretion of the Organizer. The Organizer reserves the right to reject any proposed co-exhibitor that competes with event sponsors, conflicts with venue restrictions, or does not align with the professional standards of the Event.

- **Co-Exhibitor Fee:** Upon approval, a non-refundable Co-Exhibitor Registration Fee of \$[Amount] will be charged. This fee covers the administrative cost of secondary directory listings, digital floor plan updates, and event credentials.
- **Joint and Several Liability:** Even if a co-exhibitor is approved, the primary Exhibitor remains fully and legally responsible for the entire booth space. Any breach of show rules, damage to the venue, or financial default caused by the co-exhibitor will be treated as a direct breach by the primary Exhibitor.

4. INSURANCE AND LIABILITY

- **Primary Exhibitor Coverage:** The Exhibitor must maintain comprehensive general liability insurance with a minimum limit of \$[Amount, e.g., \$1,000,000] per occurrence, naming the Organizer and the Venue as additional insured parties.
- **Co-Exhibitor Insurance:** Any approved co-exhibitor must submit their own valid Certificate of Insurance (COI) matching the same limits prior to gaining access to the exhibition floor.
- **Indemnification:** The Exhibitor agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Organizer, its staff, and the venue from any claims, losses, damages, or injuries resulting from the actions, displays, or negligence of the Exhibitor or its approved co-exhibitors.

5. COMPLIANCE WITH VENUE AND SHOW RULES

The Exhibitor and all approved guest representatives must comply fully with the official Exhibitor Manual, local fire codes, health and safety regulations, and venue guidelines. Sound levels, signage, and marketing activities must remain strictly within the physical boundaries of the assigned booth space.

6. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of [Your City/State/Country]. Any disputes arising from this Agreement shall be settled exclusively in the courts of [Your Jurisdiction].
